We will be having pizza and soft drinks provided at the museum. There will also be a raffle for 15 free admissions to the museum that can be used that day.

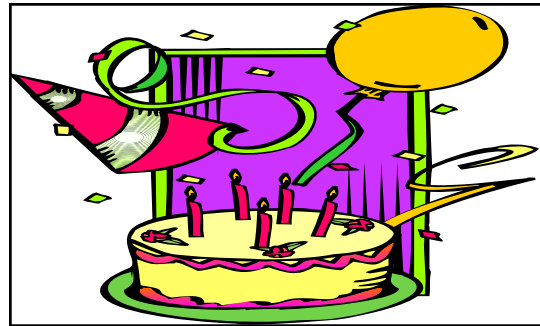
