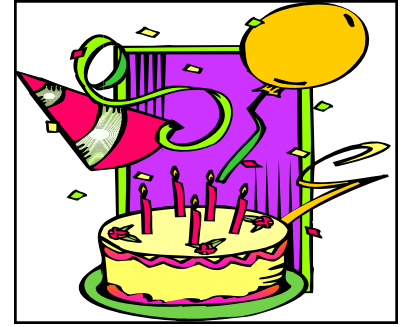
Jimmy's is not usually open on Sunday, but they made an exception for us. Let's have a good turnout to show we appreciate their decision.

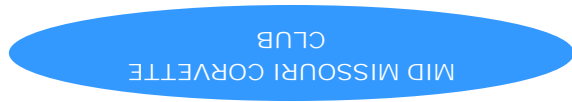
