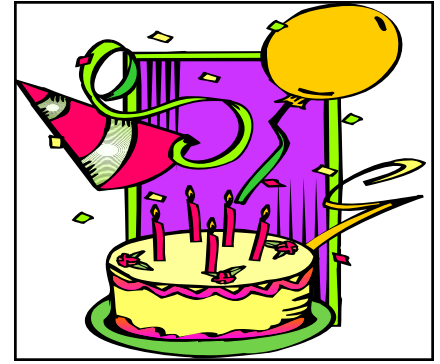

### New Business:

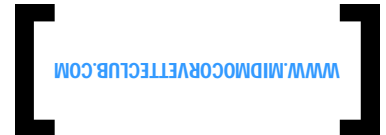
- Tommy Mallory announced that Andy's Custard donated \$100 to the club for our participation in their summer kick-off event.

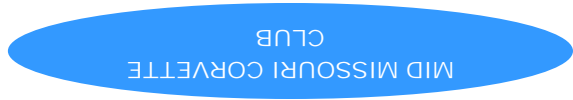
